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### Core Idea

Okay, real talk — in a Korean shop, how do I just say 'this one, please' without sounding rude?

Right? I always just point and grunt. There has to be a real phrase for it.

There is. 오늘의 핵심은 이거 주세요. In English, 'This one, please.' 이거 means 'this thing,' 주세요 means 'please give me.'

Let me show you. 카페에서 — at a cafe — you point and say, 이거 주세요. 그러면 끝이에요. That's the whole sentence.

Junho	저기요, 이거 주세요. —	Excuse me, this one, please.
Hana	네, 그거요? —	Yes, that one (near you)?



Speaker	Korean	Meaning
Junho	네, 이거 주세요. —	Yes, this one, please.
Hana	네, 여기 있어요. —	Sure, here you go.
Junho	저기요, 이거 주세요. —	Excuse me, this one, please.
Hana	네, 그거요? —	Yes, that one (near you)?
Junho	네, 이거 주세요. —	Yes, this one, please.
Hana	네, 여기 있어요. —	Sure, here you go.

## Vocabulary & Useful Expressions

Word	Meaning	Example
이거 주세요 igeo juseyo	This one, please.	There is. 오늘의 핵심은 이거 주세요. In English, 'This one, please.' 이거 means 'this thing,' 주세요 means 'please give me.'
주세요 juseyo	please give me ____	여기서 핵심은 주세요예요. 주세요는 정중하게 부탁하는 말이에요. In Korean, 주세요 marks your request as polite, not bossy.
이거 · 그거 · 저거 igeo · geugeo · jeogeo	this · that · that over there	이제 더 있어요. 이거, 그거, 저거 — this, that, that-over-there. 거리에 따라 달라요. It changes with distance.
그거 주세요 geugeo juseyo	That one (near you), please.	그거는 듣는 사람 옆에 있을 때. When it's near the person I'm talking to, it's 그거.
저거 주세요 jeogeo juseyo	That one over there, please.	저거는 둘 다한테서 멀 때. When it's far from both of us, it's 저거.
그거 = 듣는 사람 옆 geugeo = near the listener	Clerk uses 그거 because the item is near the customer (the listener), not the clerk.	When the customer pointed, I called it 그거, because the item was near you, the customer — not near me. The word follows who's nearest.
이거 igeo	this (right by me)	맞아요. 내 손 안에 있으면 언제나 이거. When it's in your hand, always 이거.



## Grammar / Structure Notes

### 이거 주세요

이거 주세요 — This one, please.

이거 = this thing · 주세요 = please give me

### 이거 주세요

이거 주세요 — This one, please.

Let me show you. 카페에서 — at a cafe — you point and say, 이거 주세요. 그러면 끝이에요. That's the whole sentence.

### 주세요

주세요 — please give me \_\_\_\_

In Korean, 주세요 marks your request as polite/kind, not bossy.

### 이거 주세요

이거 + 주세요 — This one, please.

두 조각이에요. 이거 — the thing — 그리고 주세요 — please give. 딱 두 개.

### 이거 주세요

이거 + 주세요 — This one, please.

So it's just two pieces — 'this thing' plus 'please give.' That's it?
