Core Idea

Here's my problem. I know 드리다 means "to give," but then I hear 챙겨 드릴게요. Are we giving someone... 챙기다?

좋은 질문이에요. 여기서 드리다는 물건을 준다는 뜻보다, 상대를 위해 공손하게 해 드린다는 느낌이에요.

Plain Korean might be 챙겨 줄게요, I'll take care of it for you. But for a teacher, boss, grandparent, or guest, 챙겨 드릴게요 sounds more respectful and warmer.

오늘의 패턴은 동사 어간에 아 or 어 드리다를 붙이는 거예요. In English, it means "do this action for someone respectfully."

Junho	끝나고 역까지 가야 합니다. —	Afterward, I need to go to the station.
Hana	차로 역까지 모셔다 드리겠습니다. —	We will take you to the station by car.
Hana	짐은 제가 챙겨 드릴게요. —	I'll take care of your things.
Junho	회의실은 어디인가요? —	Where is the meeting room?
Hana	제가 회의실로 안내해 드리겠습니다. —	I'll guide you to the meeting room.

Vocabulary & Useful Expressions

Word	Meaning	Example
동사 + -아/어 드리다 dongsa + -a/eo deurida	to do a verb for someone respectfully	오늘의 패턴은 동사 어간에 아 or 어 드리다를 붙이는 거예요. In English, it means "do this action for someone respectfully."
제가 해 드릴게요 jega hae deurilgeyo	I'll do it for you, respectfully.	드리다 is the humble side. The listener or receiver goes up, and I make my action sound modest.
상대를 위해 + 공손하게 sangdaereul wihae + gongsonhage	for the other person + respectfully	So the respect is not because I am fancy. It's because I'm doing something for someone I should honor.
제가 짐을 챙겨 드릴게요 jega jimeul chaenggyeo deurilgeyo	I'll take care of your luggage or things for you.	맞아요. 챙기다 becomes 챙겨 드리다. It means to take care of something for someone, respectfully.
챙겨 드릴게요 chaenggyeo deurilgeyo	I'll take care of it for you, respectfully.	챙겨 is the action, and 드릴게요 adds "I'll do it for you respectfully." Together, 챙겨 드릴게요.
제가 회의실로 안내해 드리겠습니다 jega hoeuisillo annaehae deurigetseumnida	I will guide you to the meeting room.	좋아요. 그리고 안내하다 becomes 안내해 드리다. I guide someone respectfully.



Word	Meaning	Example
안내해 드리겠습니다 annaehae deurigetseumnida	I will guide you, respectfully.	Notice the formal ending, 드리겠습니다. In service settings, this is very common and very natural.
데려다주다 → 모셔다 드리다 deryeodajuda → mosyeoda deurida	take someone there → escort someone there respectfully	맞아요. Now one special and important pair: 데려다주다 becomes 모셔다 드리다 when the person you escort is honored.



Grammar / Structure Notes

동사 + -아/어 드리다

동사 + -아/어 드리다 — to do a verb for someone respectfully

Use when you serve or help someone you want to honor.

제가 해 드릴게요

제가 해 드릴게요 — I'll do it for you, respectfully.

제가 is the doer; the respectful feeling goes toward the person helped.

상대를 위해 + 공손하게

상대를 위해 + 공손하게 — for the other person + respectfully

The action benefits the honored person.

제가 짐을 챙겨 드릴게요

제가 + 짐을 + 챙겨 + 드릴게요 — I'll take care of your luggage or things for you.

맞아요. 챙기다 becomes 챙겨 드리다. It means to take care of something for someone, respectfully.

챙겨 드릴게요

챙겨 + 드릴게요 — I'll take care of it for you, respectfully.

챙겨 is the action, and 드릴게요 adds "I'll do it for you respectfully." Together, 챙겨 드릴게요.
